Specific Duties / Responsibilities:

- To be responsible for the care of the camp horses, including feeding, watering, grooming, tacking, and healthcare needs.
- To be responsible for the care of the barn and facility including cleaning stalls, water buckets, and water troughs, and keeping the tack room, feed room, rest room, and the barn in general neat and organized.
- To teach riding lessons to groups of campers safely and in a fun way.
- To ride in the wagon to the Gym to pick up campers before the start of each class and drop them off after classes.
- To assist in camp-wide activities as needed
- Other duties may be assigned as required

Essential Functions:

- Ability to communicate and work with groups and provide necessary instruction to campers
- Ability to enforce appropriate safety regulations and carry out emergency procedures
- Ability to visually and audibly identify and respond to any environmental hazards
- Possess strength and energy to maintain constant supervision over campers while at the barn, and to take care of the horses and barn adequately.
